

Physical Presence in the U.S.

- List your **precise** periods of time **in** the United States on questions #24 & 25 of the DS-2029 application form you need to. **Do not list time spent outside the U.S.**
- For example, if :
 - You were born in Arlington VA on January 1, 1970;
 - You moved to Boston MA to study at the university on May 20, 1988;
 - You exited the U.S. to go on vacation in Mexico on June 1, 1990;
 - You re-entered the U.S. from Mexico on September 5, 1990;
 - You moved to New York on May 30, 1999;
 - You moved to Bulgaria on December 7, 2014 and continue to live here;

then you would list your physical presence as:
